 - ◉ **Mendeley Desktop** : Mendeley Desktop is the downloaded part of the software installed onto your computer. [Download Mendeley Desktop](#) if you haven't already.

Mismatch Repair (MMR) is closely linked to DNA replication; however, other than the role of the replicative sliding clamp (PCNA) in various MMR functions, the linkage between DNA replication and MMR has been difficult to investigate.
